



The Great Ontario-Hopped Craft Beer Competition Checklist

The Checklist:

Please follow this checklist to ensure you have completed all the required steps and are eligible for the competition.



Name of brewery and hopyard written clearly on each tag. Tag affixed securely to the neck of each bottle with elastic provided.



Approximately 30 g (1 oz) of each hop variety used in the beer is sealed in the baggies provided, with the variety written clearly on the label. Please ensure hops are high quality (not old).



Inform GOHCBC administrator when hops have been shipped to brewer.



Inform GOHCBC administrator when hops have been received by hops grower.



Logos for both the brewery and hopyard have been submitted to the GOHCBC. This is free advertising for you on our website.



Register for the OFVC if you plan to attend the competition in person: www.ofvc.ca



Bottles and packaging have no features that might identify the competitors and they are packed securely. Remember, Canada Post will not ship beer.

Where to Ship or Drop-off Bottles:

Bottles can be dropped off the day before the convention starts beside the conference and trade show registration desk: 6815 Stanley Avenue, Niagara Falls. Entries will be accepted by a representative between the times of 10am and 3pm on **FEBRUARY 20th** and maintained at serving temperature until the competition.
